WHAT IS THE EITC?

The Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) is a critical **anti-poverty tool** that helps families across the U.S. meet their everyday needs.

In 2021, the EITC was temporarily expanded under the American Rescue Plan Act, **increasing its value** for tax filers without dependents and granting **eligibility to young adults** ages 19-24.
